

EQUESTRIANS WITH DISABILITIES SHOWMANSHIP (WALK-TROT)




- Be ready at A.

 1. When acknowledged, trot from A, around B to C.
- 2. Walk a tight circle around C.
- 3. Trot to judge.
- 4. Stop and set up for inspection.
- 5. When dismissed, perform a 90 degree turn and walk away from judge. Follow the directions of your steward.

EQUESTRIANS WITH DISABILITIES HUNT SEAT EQUITATION (WALK-TROT)




Be ready at A.

- 1. Walk two horse lengths from A.
- 2. Trot forward and a half circle on the left diagonal until even with B.
- 3. Change diagonal and trot straight and then a half circle on the right diagonal until even with A.
- 4. Stop and back approximately one horse length.

Follow the instructions of your ring steward.

EWD Trail


EQUESTRIANS WITH DISABILITIES TRAIL WALK-JOG



- 2. Jog circle around cone jog over pole.
- 3. Stop or break to walk, walk into chute back thru poles turn and walk forward.
- 4. Jog around cones
- 5. Stop or break to walk, walk into box, execute a 360 turn either way, walk
- 6. Walk over poles.
